

CELTIC BOOKMARK

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

- 8" length of 14 count Ribband (2" wide)
- 1 skein Caron's Watercolors (Terra Cotta, Color #54)
- 1 skein DMC Embroidery Cotton (Blue, Color #792)
- A piece of white felt for finishing

NOTES:

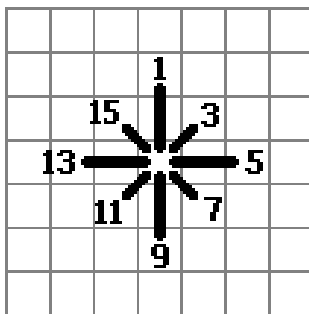
- ♥ Each line of the graph equals one thread of the fabric. Read all instructions before starting.
- ♥ One strand of thread is used throughout. The Caron's Watercolors has to be separated into three strands.
- ♥ Bring your needle up at 1, down at 2, up at 3, etc.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Start about 1" down from the top of your Ribband material.

The thicker grey lines on the pattern are stitched with one strand of the Caron's Watercolors. The eyelets and border are worked with one strand of DMC embroidery cotton.

To work the eyelet, your needle up at 1, down in the centre, up at 3, down in the centre, up at 5, down in the centre, etc.



To finish as a bookmark, stitch a piece of white felt onto the back of your stitching. As the Ribband sides are already pre-finished, you will only need to turn under the top and bottom hems. An alternate way to finish would be to fringe the top and bottom borders.
